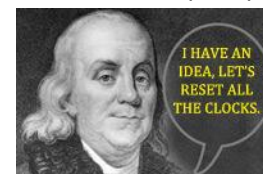
HOMEOWNER TIPS



Sick of dark mornings on your way to school or work? It's your time to rise and shine! Just like pumpkin spice, falling leaves and football, another rite of autumn is upon us: The end of daylight saving time, which will occur at 2 a.m. Sunday Nov. 5. Starting Sunday, that one hour of daylight is switched from evening to morning as standard time begins.



Credit — or blame — for the biannual shift goes back to Benjamin Franklin, who published *An Economical Project for Diminishing the Cost of Light* in a 1784 journal after he noticed that people burned candles at night but slept past dawn. But he never saw his plan put into action. The U.S. first implemented daylight saving during World War I as a way to conserve fuel with the [Standard Time Act of 1918](#), also known as the Calder Act.



Daylight Saving Time Home Maintenance Checklist

- ✓ Check batteries in your fire alarm
- ✓ Check flashlight batteries
- ✓ Check light bulbs
- ✓ Check of your fire extinguisher pressure
